NEW SafeWise Virtual Experience

We have created a digital version of our learning village for you and your pupils to explore online. SafeWise child presenters introduce dilemmas for pupils to talk about and make decisions based on their discussions, with the opportunity to explore further with a task. Pupils will be asked to watch clips and explore our learning village to complete tasks which range from design and technology, to science investigations and debates.

The topics included aim to increase resilience, creative and critical thinking, communication, decision making and questioning, self-confidence and self-awareness, motivation, community and engagement, independence and teamwork and positive thinking.

Our scheme of work and lesson plans - covering six key areas related to skills for life and safety - are accompanied by supplementary activities and book lists with extra topical resources released every half term. All our plans link with the SafeWise ethos of immersive and interactive learning.

Accompanying the new virtual tours will be an exciting SafeWise Quest Day at our centre in Bournemouth, for those schools who can travel. The SafeWise Quest Day for KS1 or KS2 classes is a fully immersive visit that allows small groups of children to complete challenges independently around the village (with their school adult as support), engaging with SafeWise actors along the way. It is especially designed to develop critical life skills through behaviours- all with our ethos of discuss, decide, and do. Each activity links back to the classroom learning we provide, so they will get the most out of the visit if they have completed this beforehand.

It will provide practical skills, enabling children to seek out new challenges, understand risks, problem solve, and review and assess their choices. A SafeWise Quest Day will contribute to a broad and balanced curriculum, and in doing so will enhance core values and beliefs. That includes resilience, creative and

critical thinking, communication, decision making and questioning, plus building self-confidence and self-awareness.
